


988 Updates



OhioMHAS and ADAMH Boards will make data-informed policy, program and resource allocation decisions that lead to measurable improvements in mental health, addiction and equity outcomes.





Focus on Equity - Plan

What's New in the CAP



Identify priority populations and groups experiencing disparities for each priority



Optional: SMART objectives for priority populations and groups experiencing disparities (disaggregated data)



Optional: Collective impact to address upstream drivers of inequities



Community Assessment and Plan: Crisis

In the SFY 2022-2023 Biennium Budget (HB 49), the Ohio General Assembly allocated funds to establish Regional Crisis Stabilization Centers and the use of Crisis Flex and Infrastructure funds throughout Ohio.

- The collected data will be able to illustrate what crisis services exist in Ohio,
- Where the crisis services are located,
- The number of individuals being served, and
- The total amount of funding and the types of funds being used to support Ohio's crisis infrastructure.


