Suicide Prevention Training:

- **FREE (QPR) Question, Persuade, Refer Gatekeeper** training is designed to teach anyone how to recognize the warning signs of suicide, know how to offer hope and know how to get help and save a life. This is 1.5 hour class in-person. qprinstitute.com
- **QPR Train the Trainer** teaches instructors to facilitate QPR Gatekeeper training in their community. This is an 8-hour class offered in-person. Cost is \$595/person through the QPR Institute. qprinstitute.com
- **FREE (CALM) Counseling on Access to Lethal Means Clinical Workshops** are designed to introduce those providing clinical services to the rationale of means safety and teach them how to plan for, initiate and carry out effective conversations with clients and their families about reducing access to lethal means - especially firearms and medications - in times of suicide risk. Workshops are typically three hours in length and can accommodate up to 30 participants in-person. www.calmamerica.org

Electronic Visit Verification (EVV):

Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) is a process for electronically capturing point-of-service information for certain home and community-based services. Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) established requirements for all states to use EVV in accordance with the 21st Century Cures Act.

This act requires CareSource to use EVV when processing Personal Care Services claims and Home Health Care Services claims.
