



2025 School-Based Behavioral Health Services Summary Report

Abstract

The 2025 School-Based Behavioral Health Services Survey highlights the continued expansion and critical role of community behavioral health partnerships in Ohio schools. During the 2024–2025 academic year, providers delivered services in 3,850 school buildings across 692 school districts, charter schools, and ESCs—a 231.9% increase since 2016. These services include clinical treatment, prevention, crisis intervention, and family engagement, reaching students at a time when youth mental health needs are at an all-time high. Despite these gains, workforce shortages, salary-driven attrition, and infrastructure barriers—particularly related to telehealth—threaten sustainability. This report calls for strategic investments in local provider capacity, non-clinical service funding, school-based telehealth infrastructure, and workforce development to ensure that every Ohio student has access to the care they need to thrive.

Introduction

The Ohio Council of Behavioral Health & Family Services Providers began tracking the landscape of school-based behavioral health (SBBH) partnerships in 2017; and since that time, partnerships between schools and community behavioral health centers (CBHCs) have increased by nearly 232%. This survey-driven effort, now in its ninth year, provides a detailed look at how CBHCs are working side-by-side with Ohio's schools to support students' mental health, improve access to care, and strengthen collaboration between families, educators, and the broader community. Year after year, this report's findings highlight the urgent need for sustained investment in school-based behavioral health services to meet students' increasing mental health needs.

During the 2024-2025 school year, CBHCs were partnered with **692 districts, charter schools, private schools, and Educational Service Centers**, reaching **3,850 school buildings statewide**. Services offered include a full continuum of prevention, early intervention, treatment, crisis response, and family engagement services, with **97.7%** providing clinical services and **83.5%** delivering evidence-based prevention programs.

As youth mental health concerns escalate, with 40% of U.S. high school students experiencing major depression and anxiety,¹ and 1-in-5 having seriously considered suicide in the past year,² access to youth mental health support is critical. Students experiencing serious mental health challenges are three times as likely to repeat a grade, twice as likely to drop out of high school, and much more likely to experience hardship into adulthood.³ Yet, only 20% of children who experience serious mental health challenges receive care from a professional, underscoring the importance of meeting students and families "where they are" in schools and the community to ensure access to critical supports.⁴ In this context, SBBH services are not a luxury, they are a lifeline.

SBBH programs do not replace family involvement, they amplify it. Parental engagement in the treatment of a child's mental health concerns does not simply end with receiving parental consent. 97.5% of SBBH providers go further: providing consultation and direct services to parents, guardians, and school leaders. These collaborative practices and wraparound supports ensure children are safe, supported, and set up for success.

Despite the growing needs of Ohio's youth, 2025 survey results continue to highlight workforce shortages and funding gaps as the primary threat to the sustainability of lifesaving SBBH programs. 79.8% of SBBH providers reported challenges with workforce recruitment and retention; and 90% cite salary as the top reason for staff turnover, pointing to funding deficits, especially for non-clinical services like prevention and consultation for parents and school administrators, as being a top contributor to the persistence of these issues.

Investing in mental health and substance use care is sound public policy and a wise economic strategy. A modest \$602 investment in prevention services results in an estimated \$7,754 cost savings per child by the time the participants are 23.⁵ Further, every \$1 spent on improved access to behavioral health treatment leads to, at least, a \$4 return on investment in improved healthcare and increased productivity.⁶ This is essential, as studies show 53% of working parents miss at least one day of work per month to attend to their child's mental health concerns.⁷ Investing in youth mental health support, however, not only leads to immediate improvements in their wellbeing, but to long-term economic stability and a healthy, productive workforce both today and into the future.^{8,9,10}

The evidence is clear: SBBH programs are built on trust, transparency, and partnership. In every region of the state, Ohio's SBBH providers are engaging families and school staff to ensure students are safe and supported. These partnerships are working, and with the right investment, they can continue to thrive. To address these challenges and meet the growing needs of Ohio's youth, this report calls for targeted investment in workforce development, sustainable funding streams for SBBH services, infrastructure improvements to support telehealth, and policies that strengthen partnerships between schools and Ohio-based community behavioral health centers.

Continued Growth of School-Based Services

In the 2024–2025 academic year, community behavioral health centers (CBHCs) partnered with 692 school districts, charter schools, and Educational Service Centers (ESCs) across Ohio, constituting a 7.1% increase from the same time last year. These partnerships now reach 3,850 school buildings statewide; highlighting the central role school-based behavioral health (SBBH) services continue to play in Ohio's educational landscape.

CBHCs are embedded within schools in a wide range of settings, reaching students in at least 1,587 elementary schools, 1,039 middle schools, 978 high schools, and 248 alternative, ESC, or specialized education settings. In response to the growing and diverse needs of students, SBBH providers are delivering an increasingly broad array of services. **92.7% of providers deliver treatment or clinical services in schools**, including individual and group counseling (87.8%), diagnostic or needs assessments (84.2%), Community Psychiatric Supportive Treatment, or CPST (72%), and Therapeutic Behavioral Services, or TBS (69.5%).

Prevention services provided by CBHCs across Ohio's schools are equally robust. In 2025, 83.5% of SBBH providers delivered Social Emotional Learning (SEL)-based prevention services, and 67.5% offered suicide prevention programming; **with 100% of providers utilizing evidence-based curricula**.

Providers also cited crisis services as an escalating area of need, with 79% reporting that Crisis De-escalation and Behavior Management was the most urgently needed service in schools, a 7.1% increase from 2024. This increase corresponds with state and national trends in the increased severity of youth mental health challenges.

While SBBH services are reaching students who may otherwise have no path to care, their impact also extends far beyond the classroom. Nearly **90% of SBBH staff are providing mental health services to families**, addressing whole-family behavioral health needs and challenges, including parents and siblings. Moreover, over **80% of SBBH providers deliver mental health services directly to school staff**, which helps improve school climate and culture and better equips teachers to more effectively support students, improving academic outcomes.¹¹ Whether providing consultation, crisis intervention, suicide prevention, or trauma-informed care, SBBH providers are equipping communities with tools to respond effectively to the youth mental health crisis. The impact of school-CBHC partnerships is felt community-wide.

The results of these partnerships are measurable. Students with access to in-school mental health services show improved grades, fewer suspensions, better attendance, and greater emotional resilience.^{12,13,14} These impacts ripple outward, supporting healthier classrooms, stronger families, and safer communities.

Collaboration with Schools & Families

One of the most powerful attributes of school-based behavioral health (SBBH) programs is their deep collaboration, not only with students, but also with families, educators, and the broader school community. According to this year's survey, **97.5% of SBBH providers engage in collaborative practices** with their school partners, including providing student-specific consultation (93.2%), offering consultation directly to teachers (87.8%), and conducting classroom-based consultation (81.1%).

More importantly, SBBH services are deeply rooted in family engagement. 2025 School-Based Behavioral Health Services Survey results reveal that **89.6% of SBBH providers are not just engaged in service delivery exclusively with students, they also provide services directly to families and caregivers**. SBBH providers consistently engage with families to address students' comprehensive social, emotional, and behavioral needs, ensuring whole-family needs are met. As concerns in recent years have risen to the forefront about a disconnect that might exist between SBBH service delivery and family engagement, 2025 survey data reveals the opposite.

SBBH partnerships are not passive. SBBH providers are embedded in school planning teams, assist in trauma-informed program development and implementation, and help guide social-emotional learning (SEL) strategies district-wide. Over **50%** help conduct school needs assessments or contribute to the development of behavioral health-related policies, ensuring the integration of mental wellness into the educational environment.

In fact, the reach of SBBH programs now extends to educators as well. **81.25%** of CBHCs reported providing at least one behavioral health service directly to school staff, including mental health consultation, wellness training and professional development, or even direct treatment services. In a time where educators face burnout and rising stress, SBBH partnerships help restore school climate, improve teachers' mental health, and stabilize the school community for students.

Telehealth: A Tool for Expanding Access to Care

As the need for school-based behavioral health (SBBH) services rises, telehealth has become an increasingly discussed tool for expanding access to care, particularly in areas with limited in-person provider availability or long waitlists. In Ohio, SBBH providers have been actively integrating telehealth into their school-based service models to ensure students access timely support. **48.8% of SBBH programs** deliver telehealth services directly in schools; and **nearly all (92.7%) have telehealth capabilities** that are used in non-school based clinical settings.

What sets Ohio's SBBH providers apart is their ability to **integrate telehealth as one tool within a broader, in-person system of care**. If students' needs escalate, or when family, school, or community coordination is required, local providers are positioned to respond quickly, provide continuity of care, and link students to more intensive services. They also bring longstanding relationships with local schools, knowledge of district policies, and the ability to engage families and school staff in shared care planning. SBBH providers noted consistent infrastructure-related barriers that limit telehealth effectiveness in school settings, including:

- Lack of private, confidential space for students to engage in sessions
- Unstable internet connectivity or limited bandwidth in school buildings
- District firewalls that block secure telehealth platforms
- Insufficient devices or equipment to support virtual care
- Limited school-level procedures or policies to guide implementation
- Difficulty collaborating with teachers and support staff in real time through virtual formats

To realize the full potential of school-based telehealth, Ohio should invest in improving the infrastructure that SBBH providers need to deliver care effectively. By equipping Ohio's existing SBBH providers and schools with the necessary tools, the state can expand access to behavioral health services in a way that builds on local strengths, deepens collaboration, and ensures students and families are fully supported, whether care happens virtually, in person, or both.

Workforce Challenges: Threatening Access to Care

Even as Ohio's school-based behavioral health (SBBH) system continues to expand, persistent workforce shortages remain the greatest threat to ensuring students receive the care they need. 79.8% of SBBH providers continue to indicate they are experiencing challenges attracting and retaining qualified staff; with more than 1-in-4 indicating that workforce recruitment and retention challenges have become more difficult compared to the previous school year. Alarming, this year more than 10.5% of organizations experienced workforce attrition rates of over 40%; with two agencies losing nearly their entire workforce in the past year.

The top reason for staff turnover remains unchanged: 90% of providers identified low salaries as the leading cause of attrition, an increase of 4.7% from last year. While recent Medicaid rate increases and improved district support have been meaningful, they have not closed the well-documented persistent pay gap between behavioral health providers operating in community-based settings compared to other practice settings, like private practice or those employed by school districts, resulting in a total of 253 full time SBBH staff vacancies statewide.¹⁵ Importantly, high turnover is not just harmful to agencies; it has direct consequences for students. When SBBH providers leave mid-year or positions are vacant, children face long waitlists, reduced access to consistent care, and delays in receiving the care they need.^{16,17,18}

Additionally, the lack of sustainable funding for non-clinical support, such as prevention programs and consultation for families and educators, limits the full scope of care that SBBH providers can offer. While Medicaid now covers a median of 60% of program costs, many critical services remain unfunded, leaving agencies unable to increase wages or invest in staff development. If Ohio hopes to preserve and grow its SBBH workforce, more stable and equitable investment is needed, not just in treatment reimbursement, but in the entire constellation of services that support families, school climate, student wellness, and whole-child care.

School-Based Services Funding Opportunities

In the 2024–2025 school year, community behavioral health centers (CBHCs) across Ohio continued to rely on a patchwork of funding to sustain school-based behavioral health (SBBH) programs. While providers receive funding from a variety of sources, including private insurance, grants, and school districts, Medicaid remains the only payor covering a substantial portion of program costs, covering a median of 60% of SBBH costs. Additionally, Medicaid and private insurances' fee-for-service reimbursement models do not reimburse for many of the non-clinical supports needed for *effective* SBBH models, including prevention, consultation, and family engagement.

77.8% of CBHCs relied on Medicaid to cover the cost of eligible services in their SBBH programs, and 71.6% had a contract with a school district, an encouraging 36.2% increase since 2023. This shift aligns with new requirements that districts use at least 50% of Student Wellness & Success Funds to address students' mental and physical health. While positive, school funding only covered a median of 4.5% of overall program budgets, and ADAMH/S Board funds, often focused on prevention, covered only a median of 15% of costs, constituting a 30.2% decrease from the previous year: underscoring the limited financial capacity of these alternate funding sources to fully sustain SBBH services on their own.

Recommendations

Ohio has made tremendous progress in expanding children's access to critical behavioral health support; and school-based behavioral health (SBBH) partnerships are creating new avenues for families to access care. But as demand for services continues to rise, providers simultaneously continue to face workforce and funding challenges that threaten the viability of these programs. Now is the time to double down on what works. SBBH partnerships are transforming lives, and with sustained investment to support a full continuum of behavioral health support, we can ensure that every Ohio child has the support they need to learn, grow, and thrive.

To preserve progress and meet the growing demand for youth mental health services, Ohio must commit to long-term, sustainable investments in both the workforce and infrastructure that support these services. Based on this year's findings, The Ohio Council recommends the following solutions.

1. STRENGTHEN WORKFORCE RECRUITMENT & RETENTION

- Expand funding for scholarships, paid internships, loan repayment, and tuition assistance programs to grow the SBBH workforce pipeline.
- Create alternate credentialing and career entry pathways (e.g., through career tech centers, associate's degrees, and accelerated programs) to help address regional workforce shortages.
- Support equitable wages for SBBH providers to reduce attrition and strengthen continuity of care.

2. INCREASE ACCESS TO SUSTAINABLE FUNDING

- Provide a dedicated, stable funding stream to support non-clinical services not currently reimbursed through Medicaid, including prevention, early intervention, consultation, and family support.
- Develop and disseminate guidance to school districts on opportunities to leverage, blend, and braid Student Wellness & Success Funds with other state and federal funding to support and develop long-term contractual partnerships with community providers.
- Work with commercial insurance carriers to recognize school-based settings as eligible places of service, expanding reimbursement opportunities across payors.

3. IMPROVE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR TELEHEALTH & IN-SCHOOL DELIVERY

- Invest in school upgrades, including broadband internet, equipment, and private spaces for telehealth.
- Partner with the Ohio Department of Education and Workforce to establish statewide guidance and implementation protocols for telehealth services within schools.
- Support Ohio community behavioral health providers who are already embedded in schools to deliver blended care models that include both in-person and virtual support.

4. EXPAND SCREENING, PREVENTION, & EARLY INTERVENTION

- Incentivize universal screening aligned with EPSDT, IDEA, and ADA to identify youth in need of services.
- Ensure funding supports evidence-based SEL and suicide prevention programs.
- Target efforts to high-risk groups, including those with family histories of mental illness or substance use, and those experiencing trauma, housing instability, or other adverse childhood experiences.

Collaborative Practices in Use

COLLABORATIVE PRACTICES

97.5% of providers indicated that they engaged in collaborative practices with school partnerships. This series of questions asked providers how they are engaging with schools, students, and families in collaborative ways. The most reported collaborative practices were:

- 89.6% of providers are engaging families to address social, emotional, and behavioral needs.
- 84.4% of providers are involved with school building/district planning (generally).
- 80.5% of providers engage in planning Social Emotional Learning (SEL) strategies.
- 79.2% of providers support planning and implementation for Trauma-Informed Practices.
- 76.6% of providers participate actively in school planning teams.
- 64.9% of providers assist with data collection & informed decision-making.
- 53.25% of providers help district develop policies related to students/staff behavioral health needs.
- 50.65% of providers assist with the conducting of school needs assessments.

CONSULTATION SERVICES

90.24% of providers are providing consultation services to schoolteachers, staff, and administrators through their school-based partnerships. The types of consultation services being provided include:

- 93.2% provide student-specific consultation.
- 87.8% provide consultation to teachers.
- 81.1% provide consultation within the classroom.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDED DIRECTLY TO SCHOOL STAFF

This year, **81.25%** of respondents reported providing one or more behavioral health service(s) directly to school staff. The types of services provided to school staff include:

- 80% provide consultation with staff regarding their personal mental health.
- 46.2% engage in prevention activities to promote teacher wellness.
- 29.2% provide treatment or clinical services directly to school staff for their own mental health.
- 24.6% deliver training and professional development to school staff.
- 16.9% conduct screening for mental health concerns with school staff.

WORKFORCE RECRUITMENT & RETENTION

- 79.8%** of school-based behavioral health providers continue to **have challenges attracting and retaining school-based staff**, a slight decrease from 2024 (-6%).
 - 25.6% of providers indicate that it has been harder to recruit and retain staff during the 2024-2025 school year compared to the same time last year.
 - 68% of providers indicate that the challenges with workforce recruitment and retention are the same compared to the same time last year.
- Turnover/attrition rates** remain a challenge for school-based programs. Of note, 10.5% of respondents have attrition rates above 41%; with two providers losing nearly their entire workforce in the last year, with an attrition rate between 91% - 100%.

WORKFORCE SHORTAGES

- 73 full time** school-based staff members were hired-away during the 2024-2025 school year from their community behavioral health agency by a school district or ESC.
 - This constitutes a **64.2% decrease** in the number of staff recruited away from their agencies by school districts compared to the same time last year, likely due to changes in COVID-era revenues, dropping off school-districts budgets.
- Agencies reported **253 full-time school-based position vacancies**, a 32.4% decrease from 374 FTE vacancies during the same time last year.

BARRIERS TO PROVIDING SCHOOL-BASED SERVICES

The #1 reason that school-based staff left their positions over the last year continues to be low salary, with this category increasing by 4.7% compared to the same time last year.

- #1 – Salary, **90%**
- #2 – Documentation Requirements, **28.75%**
- #3 – Schedule / Work Hours, **23.75%**
- #4 – Benefits, **17.5%**

The top two (2) barriers to providing school-based services are:

- #1 – Shortage of available providers/professionals, **72.5%** (10.8% decrease from 2024)
- #2 – Difficulty finding space to deliver services, **62.5%**
- #3 – Extremely High Needs & Long Wait Lists, **40%** (23.8% decrease from 2024)

Behavioral Health Funding Sources

SCHOOL-BASED SERVICES OVERALL REVENUE SOURCES

This series of questions sought to understand the sources of *any* funding SBBH providers used to finance SBBH programs. In 2025, the number of SBBH providers that received *some* financial compensation from school districts continued to increase (chart 1); a benchmark that has grown significantly over the last two (2) years, likely attributable to policy changes taking place during the same period, requiring schools to use at least 50% of Student Wellness & Success Funds to support students' mental and physical wellness. While this trend is positive, the amount of funding provided by school districts is not nearly enough to cover the full cost of SBBH programs, covering a median of less than 4.5% of agencies' total SBBH program costs (chart 2).

MEDIAN PERCENTAGE PAYOR FOR SCHOOL-BASED SERVICES

This series of questions sought to understand, on average, who are the primary payors for school-based behavioral health (SBBH) services; and asked providers to estimate the percentage of their overall budgets for SBBH programs being covered by the following sources. The data below reflects the median total of *all* providers overall school-based programs' budgets that are being covered by various payment sources.

During the 2024-2025 school year, Medicaid continues to be the primary payor for SBBH services, covering a median total of 60% of all program costs. Generally, ADAMH/S board funds were allocated to financing prevention programs; and compared to the same time last year, the median percentage of ADAMH/S Board funding covering the costs of SBBH services showed a 30.2% decrease. This decrease also coincides with a slight decrease in the number of providers *engaging* in the delivery of prevention services, which dropped from 88.5% in the 2023-2024 school year, to only 83.5% of providers during the 2024-2025 school year.
