



With the right treatment and support, people affected by a first episode of psychosis ***can*** and ***do*** get better. The opportunities for living a quality life are much greater if they receive Coordinated Specialty Care for First Episode Psychosis (CSC for FEP) ***as soon as possible after symptoms begin***. CSC for FEP is appropriate for individuals between the ages of 15-35 with recent onset of psychotic symptoms.
